Throughout its many corridors, the hotel has 56 boutique guest rooms, including 25 suites that have been designed to be as memorable as they are luxurious, each completely different.
- The renowned JSJ Design, a company known for producing exceptional interior design in the hospitality sector lead the re-launch of the historic property taking great care to preserve its distinct décor and Victorian façade.

- The hotel's Drawing Room is a welcoming retreat for guests, with an eclectic mix of warmly toned fabrics and light floral-patterned walls creating a comfortable and cozy atmosphere in which to relax and indulge in a delectable afternoon tea.
- The Library is a vibrant space with contemporary furniture and an ornate antler chandelier with shelves lined with an extensive collection of historic and antique books, some dating back to the 19th century.
- Hidden from the hustle and bustle of city life, the Terrace is a haven available to guests to soak up the glorious sunshine during the warmer months while enjoying a chilled glass of Champagne.
- Celebrities such as Elizabeth Hurley and Jane Seymour and members of the Royal family are fans of the enchanting urban hideaway.
